Intern Requirements:

- At least 18 years of age
- Completed the 40-hour Sexual Assault Advocacy Training
- In-depth knowledge of gender-based trauma (trafficking, sexual & domestic violence)
- Commit to preparatory and ongoing reading on related issues
- Meet with Supervisor(s) during business hours for bi-weekly meetings
- Have access to a computer and know how to use Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, and Excel
- **Hold a current Minnesota Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselor (LADC) license with a Bachelor's degree in Chemical Dependency, Addiction Studies or related field at minimum** (Masters level in Addiction Counseling or related field is a plus)
- Commit to at least one full semester (multiple-semester commitment is a plus) for 10+ hours a week

Intern Projects May Include:

- Conducting Rule 25 assessments for CMSAC clients
- CD Program Development
- Presenting on topics of addiction, trauma, sexual violence, healthy relationships, trafficking, rape culture, etc. to various treatment centers
- Developing CD-focused literature materials: research, writing, and designing fact sheets, brochures, Powerpoints, etc.
- Organize & update a document of in-patient and out-patient treatment centers, AA groups, etc. within our service area of Stearns, Benton, Sherburne, & Wright counties
