Mission:

To reduce all forms of commercial sexual exploitation through an accountability-focused program for men.

Program Outcomes:

Participants will...

- hear testimonies from local survivors about the impact of men's sexually-exploitative choices.
- receive information on the realities of the sex industry, prostitution, pornography, and trafficking.
- understand the attitudes, behaviors, and social forces that lay the foundation for male violence and abuse.
- recognize and interrupt their individual decision-making process to prevent further exploitation.
- receive resources and referrals.

Enrollment Process:

1. Visit www.cmsac.org/mase
2. E-mail completed intake to cmsac@cmsac.org (use subject: *MASE Intake*)
3. Call CMSAC during business hours (Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.) at 320-251-4357 to confirm that we have received your intake and money order.

Your confirmation call and \$150 down-payment will officially register you for the class.

**Please note: MASE is an equivalent to other "John Schools"/demand reduction programs across the country. MASE is not intended to be a diversion program to escape charges.*

The cost to attend MASE is \$750 and proceeds will fund victim services for survivors of sexual violence and exploitation served at CMSAC.

Referrals	CMSAC will take MASE referrals from any county.
Date	See website for next available class: www.cmsac.org/mase
Time	9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Arrive before 9. You will not be admitted if you are late. Allow plenty of time to find the building, park, and locate the room. Lunch break will be from 12-12:30. We will eat on site. Bring your own bag lunch.
Location	St. Cloud Police Department (training room) 101 11th Ave N St. Cloud, MN 56303

Class registration	After your \$150 down payment has been sent, call CMSAC during business hours (Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m.) at 320-251-4357 to confirm that we have received your intake and payment. <u>Your \$150 down payment and confirmation call will officially register you for the class.</u> If the class is full, you will be automatically registered for the next class.
To bring to class	Picture ID \$600 money order payment Non-refrigerated bag lunch
Attire	No hats, sunglasses, clothing deemed inappropriate by facilitators, etc.
Behavior	Your genuine participation and engagement is encouraged. Comments, jokes, or language deemed by facilitators to be sexist, abusive, or derogatory in nature will not be tolerated. Cell phones must either be left in your car or completely turned off. If you are seen checking your cell phone at any time (except breaks or lunch), or the ringer goes off, you will be asked to leave.
Class Completion	You will receive a certificate of completion after you successfully complete the class. It is your responsibility to provide proof of your MASE completion to your probation officer or attorney.
Class Cancellation	Occasionally class may be cancelled due to not enough participants registered. You will be notified by email or phone if this occurs a minimum of two weeks before the class. Cancellations are also listed on our website on the MASE tab. If cancelled, you will automatically be re-enrolled for the next class.
